As you journey through these lessons, you will learn how to strengthen your faith, overcome challenges, and live in the fullness of what God has destined for you.

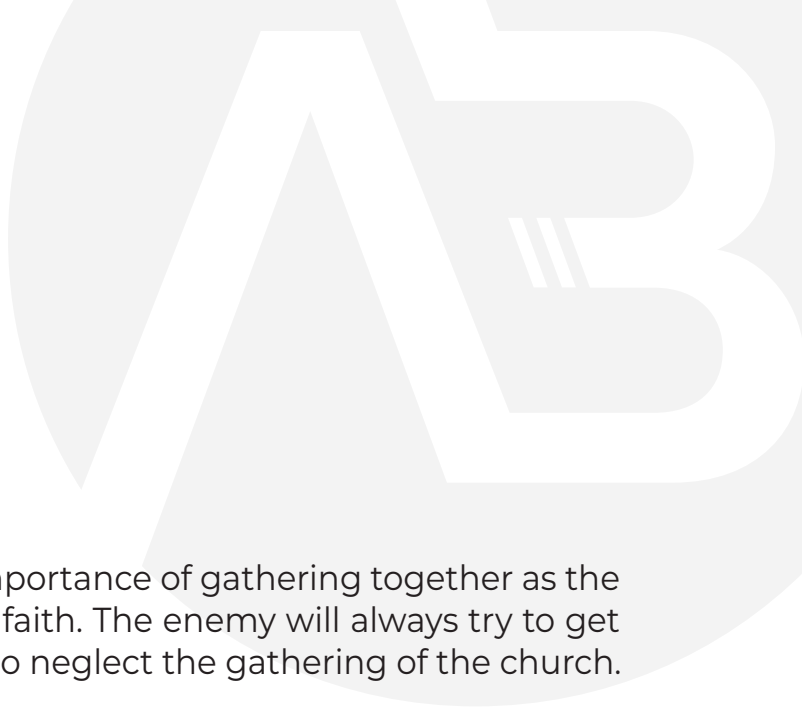
Get ready to be encouraged, challenged, and empowered. This is more than just a study, it is an invitation to live a life of active, victorious faith.

HOW TO DO THIS STUDY:

Welcome to our 4 Day “Keep your faith Alive” study. This study goes hand in hand with video lessons taught by Allan Bagg himself. Please watch the teaching on the study portal before completing the daily study application material.



Day 1



In our first session we discover the importance of gathering together as the body of Christ and how it affects our faith. The enemy will always try to get you to lose faith by trying to get you to neglect the gathering of the church.

According to Luke 18:7-8 and James 2:17-24

- **What is Jesus looking for?**
- **What type of faith is dead? What type of works should we add to our faith?**

Spend some time reflecting on the types of things we should be doing as Christians to add works to our faith in order to make sure our faith is not dead. Write it down below.

“Without faith it is impossible to please God”

- **Read the following scriptures: Hebrews 11:6, Hebrew 10:38. Describe in your own words why you think faith is important.**
- **If faith pleases God. How do we get faith? Write down practical ways that we receive faith on a regular basis.**

Read the following scriptures: Isaiah 2:2-3 & Psalm 122:1.

What have you learnt from the video session and the scriptures regarding the house of God?

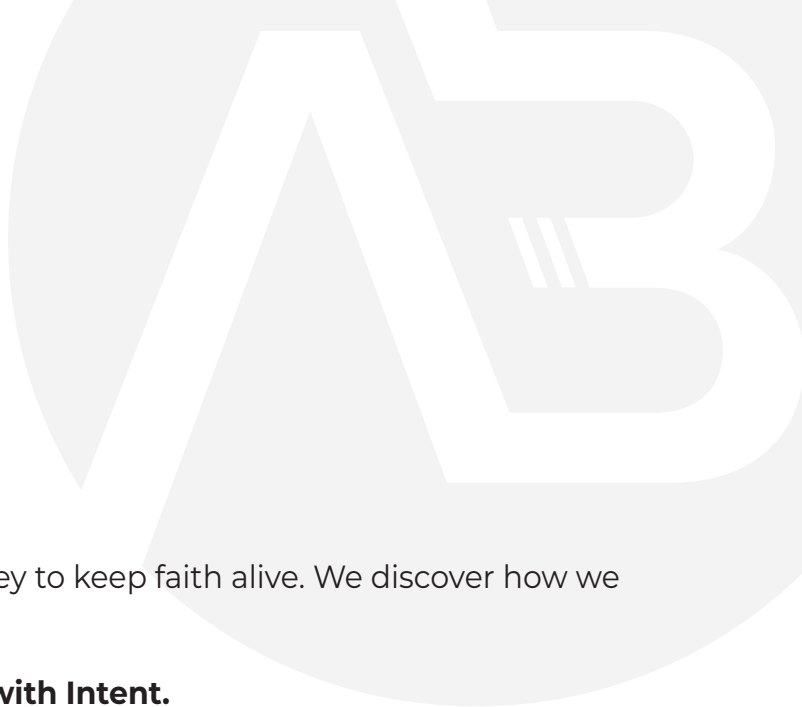
What was the first thing Allan Bagg mentioned that we require to make sure we keep our faith alive?

Key Point 1. Come to church regularly

- **Read Hebrews 10:16-25 (NKJV) and 25 (TPT)**
- **How does the Word get into our hearts?**

Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God, we can't have faith if we are not hearing the Word. God puts a pastor/teacher in our lives so that we can hear the Word. Do you have a pastor/preacher in your life? If not, ask God who He has placed in your life as your pastor.

Day 2



In today's study we look at our second key to keep faith alive. We discover how we need to listen to God's Word with intent.

Key Point 2. Listen to the Word with Intent.

Meditate on Proverbs 4:20-24, Psalm 1:1-3 and answer the following questions:

- **What are some practical ways that you can discipline yourselves to read/listen to the Word with intent and attention?**
- **Reflect and try to identify some of the ways the enemy tries to distract you from listening to the Word with intent.**
- **What are the different ways (gates) we get the Word into our heart (spirit)? What can we practically put in place to protect our hearts from being contaminated?**

Declare: *When I see the Word with my eyes, and hear the Word with my ears, together, it places the Word in my heart. Life & health comes to my body from my spirit through the Word of God.*

Key Point 3. Meditate in the Word of God Every Day

Read Joshua 1:8 and answer the following:

- **What is your understanding of good success, and how do we activate it?**
- **What is biblical meditation?**

Declare: *I am blessed. Empowered to prosper. When I meditate on the Word, the Word is activated in my life.*

Day 3



Today, we will be discussing key points 3, 4 & 5 of our 7-point Study to Keep our faith Alive by Allan Bagg.

Declare: *The bible says it is impossible to please God without faith and that the just shall live by faith. I desire to keep my Faith active and alive!*

Key Point 3. Meditate in the Word of God daily (continued)

Read 2 Corinthians 4:13 and Hebrews 3:1

- **Based on these scriptures, why is it important for us to pay attention to what we say?**

Declare: *The Spirit of faith is that I speak what I believe. Jesus is the High Priest of my confession.*

There is a subtle difference between a fact and the truth. Can you name some examples to illustrate the difference?

Declare: *Facts change, the truth is established. The truth can change facts. Based on the declaration above, let's look at the following example. If I am not feeling well and am experiencing symptoms, what is the fact and what is the truth? How should I speak?*

- **Do not say:** I am sick (**do not take ownership of sickness**)
- **SAY:** I am resisting symptoms in my body (**fact**), however by Jesus stripes I have been healed (**truth**)

Key Point 4. Be Courageous

Read Joshua 1:3;5;7

- **What assurance do we have when we face or are about to face giants?**
- **How do we respond to an occurring or increased onslaught of the enemy? (Think symptoms getting worse etc.)**

Key Point 5. Fight the Good Fight of Faith

Read 1 Timothy 6:12 and 2 Corinthians 10:5

- **What do we do when negative thoughts try to invade our minds?**

Illustration: *Count to 10 in your mind then shout out "Jesus loves me!"*

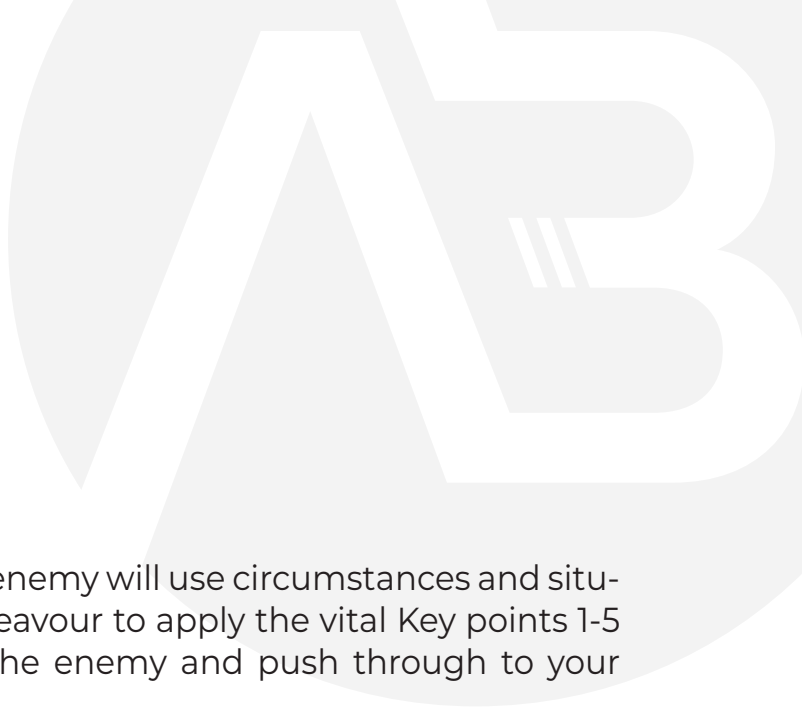
Declare: *God has designed my mind to keep thinking until I speak a word, His Word. Words supersede thoughts.*

- **A good fight is a fight that we win! Reflect on a time where you kept the faith alive, held fast to your confession and saw the promise fulfilled, despite challenges that arose.**

Declare: *My victory is guaranteed, but there is a fight of faith. I gladly take up the fight of faith as I stand on the Word of God!!*



Day 4



In today's study we discover that the enemy will use circumstances and situations to come against us as we endeavour to apply the vital Key points 1-5 to our lives. Discover how to resist the enemy and push through to your victory!

Key Point 6. Stand – Stand – Stand

What do we do when people or circumstances come against us?

Read Ephesians 6:14-18 and answer the following:

- **How does “the breastplate of righteousness” apply to us standing?** *(Hint: Right standing)*
- **How does “the shield of faith” apply to us standing?** *(Hint: How do we use a shield. “FIERY arrows”)*
- **How does the “helmet of salvation” apply to us standing?** *(Hint: How does a helmet protect and why?)*

Key Point 7. Praise & Thanksgiving

What if we have done everything and attacks still come. What must we do?

Philippians 4:6-7 *“Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”*

Psalms 8:2, *“Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have ordained strength (praise), Because of Your enemies, That You may silence the enemy and the avenger.”*

What does the Bible say silences the enemy?

It is our responsibility to always keep our faith alive. (Points 1-7) Take some time to write down your personal action plan to ensure you will keep your faith alive by applying the 7 Key points in this study.

Congratulations on completing the “Keep Your Faith Alive” Daily Study! By walking through these key principles, you have been reminded that faith is not passive but active, it requires action, courage, discipline, and perseverance.
